Selection criterion

- Any individual(s) or organization(s) / Company(ies) interested in exhibiting during the UASDGC 2023 can submit a proposal;
- Owing to time and other considerations, only those whose proposals will be accepted will exhibit;
- The submission must be on the exhibition request form, providing a detailed description of the exhibition (one pager), the organizers and how the exhibition would contribute to Sustainable Development;

Applicants will be informed of the results of the selection process and a list of all exhibitors will be published after review.

Individuals and organizations are invited to submit their proposals for Exhibitions using the Exhibition Request Form by $\frac{15^{th} \text{ May 2023}}{15^{th} \text{ Conference}}$. Please note that the exhibitions will take place concurrently with the conference on $21^{st} - 23^{rd}$ June, 2023.
